Presentation

Training

Thursday 29th and Friday 30th some layouts will be open for training from 10.00 to 18.00. Price 80 SEK/25 targets. There is also going to be some sort of fun competition.

Competition

The competition starts Saturday May 31st and ends Sunday June 1st. In total 200 clays divided on 8 different layouts. Registration fee 2 000 SEK. 100 clays per day. The layouts utilize voice release and results are registered digitally. Results are presented online at svegerasen.se.

We will use certified head referees and they are going to be supported by a selection of the participants.

The competition is planned for 320 participants. The time schedule is using a tempo of 2.30 minutes per station, which with a starting time of 09.00 gives an ending time before 16.00. That is with smooth going without disturbances.

The individuals are competing in the following categories: Junior, Lady, Senior, Veteran, Master (min. 5 participants) and Open. The National teams are competing in categories Juniors, Ladies, Men, Seniors and Veterans

Sponsored prizes to High Gun, Runner Up, Third to Fifth place.

Ammunition

In Sweden only steel ammunition is allowed and for the competition US6-US9 max 28g can be used.

Accommodation

Cities closest to Svegeråsen is Trollhättan (38 km), Vänersborg (36 km), Lidköping (33 km), Skara (40 km), Falköping (48 km) which all have hotels (see booking.com etc.).

Registration

Registration is done at lerduvor.net. There are 5 competitions initially, one for each Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Norway and Iceland. Shooters should use the competition that is directed to their country for a valid registration.

Registration for individuals is done in the following classes: Junior, Lady, Man, Senior, Veteran and Master.

For national teams the classes are Juniors, Ladies, Men, Seniors and Veterans. Send the composition of national teams to ordforande@svegerasen.se.

When the quota for a country is full, there is a waiting list, where potential participants are recorded in chronological order of sending a mail to ordforande@svegerasen.se stating that they want to participate.

Payment

The registration is complete when paid. Until then you are only on the interest-/waiting list. The quotas are counted on complete registrations. Being on the waiting list does not assure participation.

Quotas

To get a fair distribution of shooters from different countries quotas are used. We are working with a maximum number of participants of 320. The quotas are:

Sweden	95
Denmark (including Ferry Islands and Greenland)	70
Finland (incl. Åland Islands)	70
Norway	70
Iceland	15

The Shooting Federation in each country selects the shooters for the national teams, that means 15 participants.

April 15th

On 15th of April the quotas are reconciled and updated.

Arrival

On arrival to the competition fetch your competition number plate, which must be worn according to the international rules.
